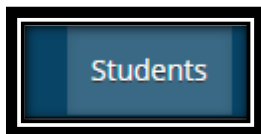


Using 'My Content' to save resources

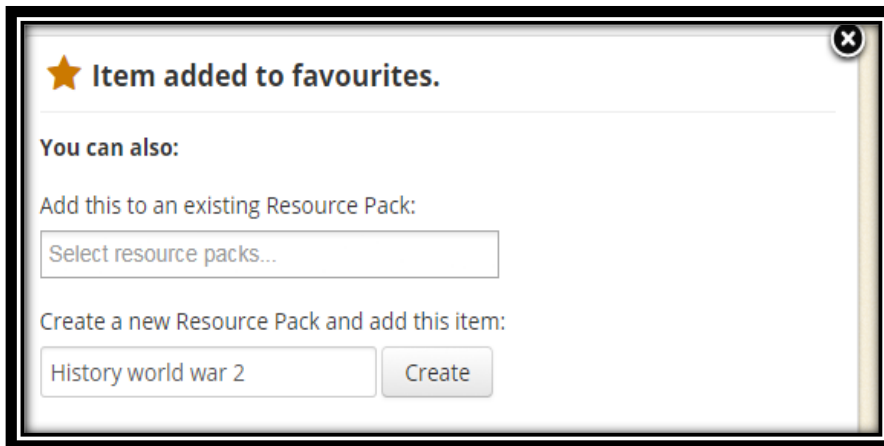

You will then be prompted to either create a new resource pack or add the article to an existing resource pack. I created one called 'History World War 2'

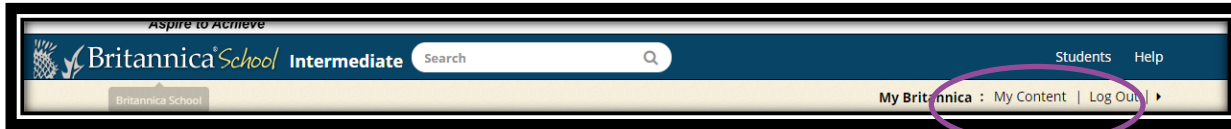

You can also:

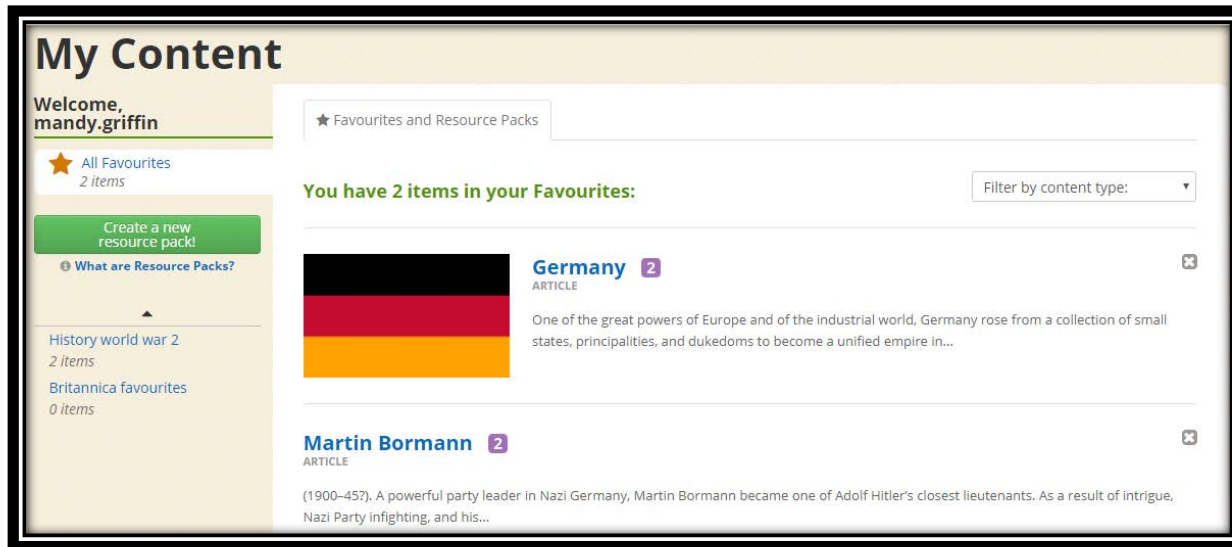
Add this to an existing Resource Pack:
